Keeping Children Safe

The safety of our children is paramount – please don't let them jump on the fences, climb on the sheds or balance on the walls. Children often copy what they see adults doing so please do not lift your child up to press the release button for the gate.

What is a verruca?

Verrucas - sometimes called plantar warts or spelled verrucae - are warts that develop on the soles of the *feet*. ... It can take



some weeks, or even months, for a *verruca* to appear after you have contracted the infection. This is called the incubation period. Like other viral infections, verrucas are contagious.

Verrucas come and go very quickly in children.

If you get a verruca, cover it with a waterproof plaster or a special verruca sock for swimming or PE lessons at school

Don't scratch or pick your verruca as this could make it spread to other parts of your body
