We are excited to inform you that as part of our History topic (What happened when the Romans left? Also sometimes known as the Dark Ages), children in year 4 will have the opportunity to visit the Anglo-Saxon Village at Wildwood, Escot. During the day the children will take part in a range of 'living history' activities to experience some aspects of what life would have been like during the Anglo- Saxon times. This will include dressing up in traditional clothing, a foraging walk and baking bread, helping a blacksmith and wood carving. The trip will take place on **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October**.

**Times:**
