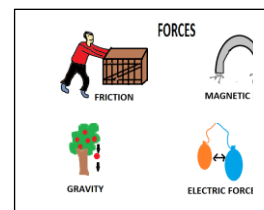


Year 5 Learning Letter Autumn 2 Term
