We have been carefully considering a number of ways to improve our offer to parents and children and the following idea is based on a desire to improve the transition from home to school and back again at the end of the day. We would like to open the doors into classes at 8.50am to allow parents ten minutes of flexible time before the doors close at 9am. In year two, we would operate a one way system that would allow parents to walk up to the classrooms with their children if they wished. This would provide time for parents and teachers to communicate informally. At the end of the day we would like to open the doors at 3.20pm in order to allow parents to collect children from the Infant school first before collecting older siblings from the Junior school. We are proposing that this change will take place at the beginning of the summer term (18th April 2017 onwards) but are open to ideas. We have been in contact with FISH and they are able to accommodate the alteration. Please be assured that we are interested in your views about this proposal and would welcome your comments
