Last Friday we were visited by two members of Devon's School Improvement Team. They spent the whole day with us, watching every teacher teaching, discussing various aspects of the school with different leaders and governors, and analysing our paperwork. At the end of the day they said that:

- The quality of teaching is good and supported by evidence in pupils' work this term.
- The quality of leadership and management is good.
- The progress made since the last inspection is good.

They also gave us some things to keep working on, particularly continuing to raise standards in maths and making sure that disadvantaged children do as well as possible.

We are very pleased with the report, and will keep working hard to make sure the school is as good as it can be.
