## Educational Visit to Dawlish Warren

Dear Parent / Carer,

As part of our Science and topic work on habitats and environment, we have arranged an educational visit for Year 4 to Dawlish Warren for each year 4 class:

- **4RC** Tuesday 27th June
- **4RM** Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June
- **4KH** Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June

We will be travelling by train – from Polsloe Bridge to Dawlish Warren. Children will need to arrive at school at the usual time, then we will walk down to the station ready for the 10:46 train.

We will get the 14:56 train back from Dawlish Warren, which arrives back at Polsloe Bridge at 15:25. This means **we will not be back to school until about 3:45pm.**

During our visit, the children will be led in some activities at the Visitors' Centre and the nature reserve by one of the Rangers. We will also organise some activities of our own. If we have a few minutes spare to go onto the beach, the children will not be allowed to paddle in the sea.

The trip will cost **£2.25**, or **£1.10** for those in receipt of the pupil premium grant. Payment can be made via Parent Mail, in which case you don't need to return the below slip. Alternatively, hard copies are available at reception for cash payments.

Your child will need the following:

- Suitable outdoor clothing – with a waterproof jacket and **school sweatshirt**.
- Sun cream & hat
- Rucksack for their things
- Packed lunch
- Extra drink
- Money for an ice-cream, if you wish
- Inhalers – children with asthma
