## Infant and Nursery Newsletter

### ADDITIONAL FUNDING

**Universal Free School Meals** All children in Key Stage 1 are automatically entitled to a free school meal. The criteria for Pupil Premium is similar to Free School Meals applications.

**Pupil Premium** is additional funding given to state-funded schools in England. If any of the benefits below apply to you, it means that the school is able to receive additional Pupil Premium funding.

- Income-based and contribution-based JSA or ESA on an equal basis
- Income Support (IS)
- Income based jobseekers allowance (IBJSA)
- Income-related employment and support allowance (IRESA)
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, that does not exceed £16,190

Forms have gone out today to every child and we ask all parents to complete it (*regardless of whether you receive any benefits*) so that it enables the school to know about every child on roll who is eligible for the Pupil Premium additional funding.

Likewise, if you wish your child to stay to a hot dinner but he/she has a severe allergy it is very important that you meet with Mrs Hoare, the kitchen manager and mark off on the lunch menu what he/she can eat.

We need to ensure that children are properly catered for in school at all times.
