#### Application for Infant/ Primary School – September 2017

If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2013 (inclusive) you need to be thinking about applying for school. The application process for primary and junior places will close on 15 January 2017.

Please make sure you complete an Admission Form online. **Admissions to schools are not automatic** – every place has to be applied for regardless of what school you would prefer.
