#### **Internet Safety**

Nic Unsworth, our local PCSO from Devon and Cornwall police came to speak to the children in year 6 this week. We discussed the different social media platforms used by the children, including Instagram, Fortnight, Minecraft, PUBG, Tic Toc, YouTube, WhatsApp, Skype and Snapchat. We learned that Musically, which was popular until recently, has been banned due to the levels of online bullying taking place within it. The developers simply re-released the app with a few changes and a new logo and named it Tic Toc!

We talked about the importance of the security settings so that the children are not sharing their information with unknown members of the public and to avoid location settings being active. Nic recommended <a href="https://www.commonsense.org">www.commonsense.org</a> which gives help and guidance to children and adults about how to help children thrive in our rapidly changing world.

We discussed age restrictions which are in place for most social media apps; children need to lie or create fake identities in order to create accounts.

A study found that 79% of young people use the internet unsupervised or without the their parents knowing.

Children often think that things they have posted online or messaged to a friend can be deleted but Nic reminded us that nothing ever goes away once it is posted online.

Amongst other advice, Nic told the children to remember the following:



- Report Abuse to report any concerns.
- Delete or block unknown people
- Be careful about what you share online
