Year 5 trip to R.A.M.M.

On Tuesday, year 5 enjoyed a fascinating trip to the Royal Albert Memorial Museum in Exeter. The purpose of the trip was to investigate ancient artefacts and whether we can learn anything from them today. The children used an archaeological field journal to record anything they found interesting, unusual or worth recording.

Anju in 5NW said, "It was very good because we saw an ancient Greek helmet and some Egyptian sarcophagi."

Many of the children were curious about the stories and messages on some of the Greek pottery. Some conversations between the children included: What is the story on the vase about? Are these people famous? Why would anyone record this?

Year 5 will be using their fact finding mission to help curate their own museum exhibition on Greek artefacts, over the coming weeks.


