

## Olympic Wreath Activity

If an Olympic athlete won an event during the ancient Olympic Games, a wreath woven out of olive branches —symbolizing peace in ancient Greece—was placed upon his head. Use a strip of paper and collect some leaves. Arrange the leaves and attach them to the card to create your own winner's wreath!



Legend says that the olive tree from which they made wreaths for the Olympic champions, was planted by semi-god Heracles at Olympia where the Olympics were taking place in ancient Greece and where they got their name from.
