Children should be recording their reading in their Reading Records.

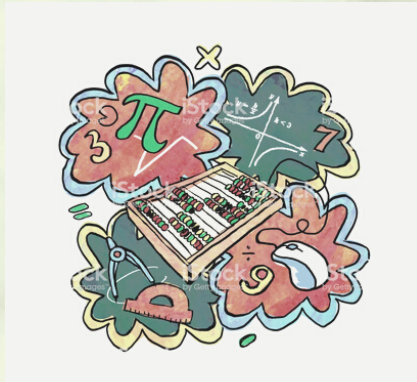
These need to be completed by the children, and then be signed, weekly, by an adult.

- Multi-step addition and subtraction problems



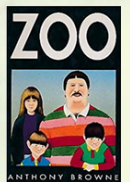
### ENGLISH LEARNING
