Dear Parents / Guardians,

We are excited to inform you that as part of our History topic (What happened when the Romans left? Also sometimes known as the Dark Ages), children in year 4 are going to have the opportunity to visit the Anglo-Saxon Village at Wildwood Escot. During the day, the children will take part in a range of 'living history' activities to experience some of what life would have been like during the Anglo- Saxon times. This will include dressing up in traditional clothing, a foraging walk and striking an Anglo- Saxon coin. The trip will take place on the following dates:

4NM: Tuesday 25th September.

4AN: Wednesday 26th September.

4RC: Thursday 27th September.

Times:

We will be travelling to Escot by coach leaving school at 9:15am and will return to school at approximately 3:00pm so normal drop off and pick up times apply. Children will be required to bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink for the day.

Clothing:

Many of the activities will be happening outside so it is important that your child is dressed in suitable footwear and appropriate clothing for the weather including waterproof coats or hats and sun cream if needed.
