### Food Technology

### Safety Concerns

We still have serious concerns about the manner in which some people are parking on the yellow zig-zag lines and yellow lines outside school.



**Rule 238 of the highway code states that:**

*You MUST NOT wait or park on yellow lines during the times of operation shown on nearby time plates (or zone entry signs if in a Controlled Parking Zone) – see 'Traffic signs' and 'Road markings'. Double yellow lines indicate a prohibition of waiting at any time even if there are no upright signs. You MUST NOT wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings (see 'Road markings') when upright signs indicate a prohibition of stopping.*

We will be noting when vehicles stop or park on the yellow lines and informing parking enforcement in an effort to improve this situation before a serious accident occurs. We would like the children in all year groups to help us celebrate **World Book Day** by dressing up as a fictional character from a book.


All children will receive a **£1** book token which can be exchanged in any participating high street bookshops.
