### World Cup Tournament

Entry forms are available from Mr Broad and the School Office from Monday onwards. Once the entry forms have been handed back in they won't be able to be changed, and children can only be entered as members of one team.

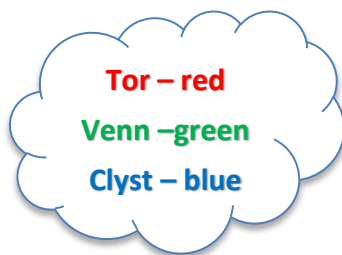
## Sports Days
