There's a brand new section on the DIAS [website](#) about EHC needs assessment. The information is aimed at parents and carers and walks you step by step through the process - from thinking about whether your child or young person might need an assessment, through to what happens during a needs assessment. There are supporting materials too, including: • a film about EHC plans • a factsheet about asking for an assessment and filling

out the request form and • forms to help you or your young people share your views. Each page of Information has links to further resources. Parent stories about EHC needs assessment will be coming soon.
