MATHS LEARNING

Statistics

Complete, read and interpret information in tables, including timetables.

Solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in a line graph.

Multiplication and Division

Identify multiples and factors, including finding all factor pairs of a number, and common factors of two numbers.

Solve problems involving multiplication and division including using their knowledge of factors and multiples, squares and cubes.

Measuring Area and Perimeter

Measure and calculate the perimeter of composite rectilinear shapes in centimetres and metres.

Calculate and compare the area of rectangles (including squares), and including using standard units, square centimetres (cm²) and square metres (m²) and estimate area of irregular shapes.
