2. Decide on the *type* of poem. Write your answer in the box.

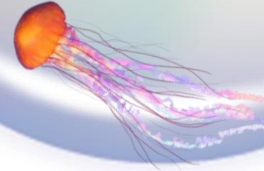
Our headteacher
