Thank you to all of those who have returned the parent questionnaires. Your views will help us to make improvements to the way in which we organise our assemblies, seek parent opinions and work together on projects. Here is a summary of the 60 questionnaires that were returned:

- The majority of respondents (48) would be able to attend an assembly on a Friday at 3pm if given a few days' notice
- Eight respondents would be able to attend with a weeks' notice.
- Three would not be able to attend and three would need longer than a week
- Everyone thought a parent forum was a good idea, with the exception of one
- Thirty nine respondents would be able to attend a forum and fifty one would be willing to talk to a parent representative
- Twenty respondents would be willing to be a parent representative
- Twenty respondents offered to share time and skills on projects at school

We will now use these results to plan some improvements..... watch this space!

Application for Infant/ Primary School – September 2017

If your child was born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2013 (inclusive) you should have applied for a school. The application process for primary and junior places closes on **Sunday 15 January 2017**. <u>https://new.devon.gov.uk/educationandfamilies/school-information/apply-for-a-school-place/apply-for-a-primary-school-place</u> Applications made after 15th January 2017 will be classed as late and may lead to disappointment due to all the places being filled.
