What makes the Big Wild Sleep Out Unique?

- Exclusive access to some beautiful private areas of the RSPB Aylesbeare- camping is not usually
 allowed on Aylesbeare or anywhere on the Pebblebed Heaths in order to protect the important
 wildlife there so this is a unique opportunity to spend a night out in the wild.
- This event contributes to looking after this special place, it also raises funds for Ladysmith CPTT
- Get out into the wild, discovering wildlife with friends and families

 enjoy being on the reserve for the evening, night and following morning with the RSPB team there
 to guide activities and provide a delicious dinner and breakfast

 May (last day of the half term)
