COVID-19 WEEKLY UPDATE



End of term dates

Firstly, I would like to let you know that the last day of term for the children in both Ladysmith Schools will be Friday 18th December as planned. This **will not** be an INSET day as some schools are implementing following the latest DfE guidance. We know that parents have planned for this and will have organised their work accordingly. At this very challenging time we want to ensure that things stay as certain as they can in this respect. It is also important that our children stay within their school routine until the end of this term planned timeframe.

The first day of the spring term will remain as Tuesday January 5th 2021 for the children.

What to do if your child develops Covid symptoms during the Christmas break

- ⇒ **If your child develops covid symptoms within 48 hours of their last day in school, (Saturday 19th or Sunday 20th December) we ask that you notify us via email of your intention to get a Covid test and then ask that you inform us of the result. In the event of a positive case, we will then identify close contacts and inform those children's parents via email of any need to isolate.**
- ⇒ **If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school does not need to be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.**
