Well Done to all of the Team Player Penguins.

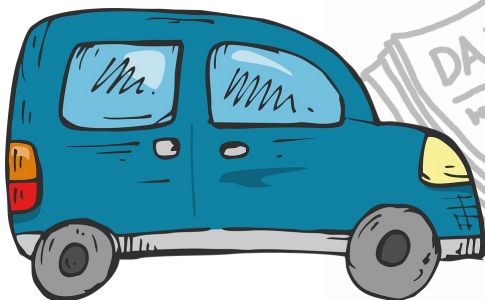
