School Closure

The Junior School will be closed on Tuesday 18th and Wednesday 19th April 2017 to enable transition into the new build. The Infant and Nursery School is <u>not</u> closing for the two days, and the Infant school children will be expected to attend school regardless of whether their sibling is off. We believe that every day is important in a child's education and that attendance is vital. This is especially true at the start of term when new topic "hook days" occur and children are introduced to the theme for the learning that will occur over the term. For this reason, unjustified school absence will be given an 'unauthorised absence mark'.

Ambition Adventure Achievement

Every day is full of adventure at Ladysmith, and the children spend over five hours a week outdoors in the playground areas. We are keen to increase the quality of the play occurring during these times and are going to be working with OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) to change the ethos around playtimes.
