Ambition Adventure Achievement

We love the fact that our children are using the Play Trail every day. The **OPAL** project works on the basis that:

A hazard is something that a child cannot see.

A risk is a challenge that a child chooses to undertake or not.

Eliminating risk leads to a child's inability to assess danger.

In the mornings before school and after school it is the responsibility of the parents to supervise their children and help them to assess risks for themselves. We do not supervise children using the equipment at these times but would appreciate your help and intervention if you see your child:

- Involved in play which is dangerous to themselves or another
- Involved in play that causes damage to property or equipment

If all adults are consistent with these messages then the children will very quickly be able to risk assess their play independently. If you spot a hazard, then please let us know so that we can act to keep our children safe.


