Read for My School



Read for My School is a national schools reading competition that promotes reading for pleasure by challenging pupils to read as many books as possible in three months. Throughout the competition there are prizes and awards to be won for schools and pupils taking part.

We would like the children to read as many and as wide a range of books as they can in the three months of the competition. The website includes a library of over 100 online books to choose from and all participants can access these freely throughout

the competition. Books to suit the full range of reading abilities are available. The books are organised in eight genre-categories and we would like children to aim to read books from a range of categories. Children may also choose to read any book of their choice offline and then log what they have read via their Read for My School account. Other key features of the programme include:

- Read for My School is fully compatible with most major tablets and can be accessed via Kindle and iPad so that children can access books in whatever way they find most enjoyable.
- Read for My School will run from 18th January to 15th April 2016.

Children will need to log in to www.readformyschool.co.uk and create an account from 18th January.

You will need our 'classroom code' to sign up, which is: **854056**We will be talking to the children about this on Monday during assembly.
