Lois and Henry have recently donated some of their compost to the new planters on Heavitree Fore Street as part of the [Interwoven project](#).

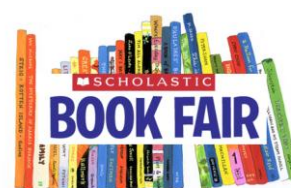
The project aims to celebrate and improve the Heavitree area and the planters will soon be appearing in the area. What a lovely example of Ambition, Adventure and Achievement!
