School Crossing Patrol

We have been informed by Devon County Council that providing a School Crossing Patrol is not a statutory function and parents remain responsible at all times for the safety of their children on their whole journey to and from school. DCC have many vacancies for School Crossing Patrols at various schools across Devon.

Could you be a LOCAL HERO ? Join the School Crossing Patrol Team.

- Rate of pay £7.78 per hour
- Patrols work approx. five to seven hours per week during the school term.
- Uniform, full training and ongoing support is provided.
- Clearance from the Disclosure and Barring Service (formerly CRB) is required, which we will pay for.
- A medical assessment is required prior to appointment and regular assessments must be undertaken thereafter.



School crossing patrols help children and other pedestrians cross the road safely while they are walking to and from school at a designated point/s and between specified times.
