

Staying Healthy and Happy

NHS advice for parents and carers During these unsettling times, you may have health and wellbeing concerns about your baby or child and be unsure how to get the help you need. Our local health visitors are still here to help. If you are a parent or carer and want confidential advice and support about your baby or child aged up to 19 years old, then you can text a health visitor on: 07520 631 721. They are available 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday and can offer help on a wide range of issues such as mental health, family health and development, sleeping and feeding routines and adjusting to parenting.

If you are pregnant it is important that you still attend your antenatal appointments and continue to seek advice from your midwife or maternity team. If you are worried about your health or the health of your unborn baby, please contact your midwife or maternity team. If you are worried about the health of your baby or child, please call 111. If it's a serious or life-threatening emergency, call 999.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS: All those in receipt of Free School Meals will receive a hamper of food worth £20. This can be collected from school every Monday on a weekly basis. If you fall into one of the following categories, you can apply for the Pupil Premium Grant, and will qualify for Free School Meals. Applications need to be made via the Devon Citizens Portal - on the DCC website : <https://www.devon.gov.uk/supportforschools/services-and-contacts/free-school-meals> . To qualify you need to be claiming one of the following:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- *Child Tax Credit—providing you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income, as assessed by HMRC


