

Year 4 Learning Letter

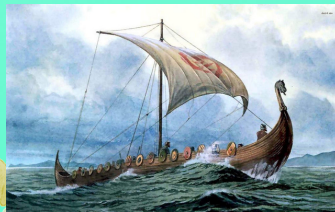

Key learning in Maths

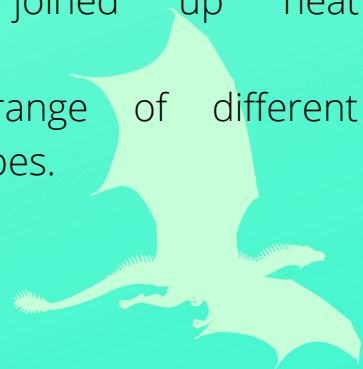
- Multiply and divide by 10, 100, 1000
- Use Times tables and division facts up to 12x to solve problems
- Use written methods to multiply and divide up to three digit numbers by one digit.

- Using sub headings and headings to organise non fiction
- Using adverbials and adverbs
- Practising joined up neat handwriting.
