Spring 1 in Reception: Traditional Tales

This half term we will be listening to and learning traditional stories. We will become familiar with story structures and characters by listening to, watching and acting out traditional tales, bringing these into our play and independent learning provision. We will be learning key phrases and vocabulary from these stories, using songs, drama and roleplay to help us retell stories in meaningful and creative ways and learning to create 'story maps' to retell key elements of stories. We will listen to alternative versions of familiar tales, exploring and enjoying the ways in which authors and illustrators have changed stories and experimented with language and story-telling. Using what we have learnt in our phonics lessons, we will begin to write words and sentences to help us write character names and retell traditional tales. We will continue to explore the natural world and describe what we see, hear and feel outside by taking part in the RSPB 'Big Garden Bird Watch', visiting our local cemetery and park to see which birds

we spot and find out about our local area.
