
There will be a weekly spelling test (on Fridays). The children can practice for this on Spelling Shed or in their homework book.

Units Covered


Measurement: Area and perimeter Multiplication and division

Key objectives:

Measure and calculate the perimeter of composite rectilinear shapes in centimetres and metres.

Multiply and divide numbers mentally drawing upon known facts.

Multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a one or two-digit number using a formal written method, including long multiplication for 2-digit numbers. Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a 1-digit number using the formal written method of short division and interpret remainders appropriately for the context. Solve problems involving addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and a combination of these, including understanding the
