


Telling the Time

Learning to tell the time is a great way to support your children at home.

Younger children can have a go at counting the numbers around the clock face and learning o'clock times. Children in Key Stage 1 learn to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past. Moving on to telling the time at 5-minute intervals by the end of Year 2.

Have a go at making your own analogue clocks at home, paper plates are great for this, and enjoy telling the time together.
