## Maths

### Units covered:

- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division

### Key learning:

- Assign and subtracting two numbers with and without exchanges
- Inverse operations
- Multiples of 2, 5 and 10
- 3,4- and 8-times tables

## Writing

### Key Texts:

- Skara Brae
- The Secret of Black Rock by Joe Todd-Stanton

### Key Learning:

- Write a persuasive holiday brochure
- Add detail to narratives through expanding noun phrases
- Create plot, setting and characters in a narrative piece

## Home Learning

Please learn weekly spellings, including their meaning, by Friday each week. We will complete an activity based on these words each Friday.

Please continue enjoy reading daily at home. Spend time talking about the characters, pictures and everything that has happened in the book to really capture imagination and interest. Daily reading should be recorded in the yellow reading record which will be checked on a Friday.

## Geography

Our geography learning this half term will explore the enquiry questions 'How and why is my local environment changing?'

## Science

We will be learning all about light and will be exploring reflections, shadows and different sources of light.

## PSHE

Our over-arching unit title is 'Celebrating Difference'. We will be celebrating what makes us unique and discuss solutions to conflict.

## RE

We will be learning and answering the question 'What is it like or someone to follow God?'

## ART/DT

We will be using watercolours to create art linked to our geography learning.

In DT we will be making pneumatic toys.
