
Year 6 Learning Letter Spring Term 2














Wow, we can't believe we are over halfway through the year! We are very excited for the learning we will be doing this half term and hope that the children are as equally excited and motivated.

Maths

Units covered:

Statistics
Shape
Position and Direction

Key learning:

Interpreting different types of graphs and charts
Understanding shape and their properties – in particular using angles to solve problems
Understanding coordinates, reflections and translations

Geography

Our topic this half term is Rivers. We will be focusing on the River Axe, plotting the journey from mouth to source and learning about the wildlife along the river.

PSHE

Our focus will be *Healthy Me*. We will consider how to take responsibility for a physical and mental health, manage our stress and emotions and consider threats to our health.

Science

Our unit is Evolution and Inheritance. The children will learn about:

- The theory of evolution
- How fossils provide evidence for evolution
- How animals have adapted to suit their environment.
